PBIS

Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports

At Fairview we are looking to start the year off right by participating in expectation stations. On Friday, each classroom will review schoolwide PBIS expectations by rotating through review stations. Students will review expectations for the lunchroom, recess, hallways, restrooms, and before and after school. On Friday, ask your students to share what they reviewed at each station. When students are meeting school expectations, they are able to focus on learning! At Fairview we are fired up for success!

Attendance

Did you know that attendance is a factor in Fairview's school rating every year? You can support Fairview by supporting your students in having great attendance!

When a student misses 10% of school days, they are considered chronically absent. When students are chronically absent, they miss out on vital instruction and learning at school.

As always, please do not send students to school ill. If a student is ill, has not been fever free for 24 hours, or has vomited in the past 24 hours, please do not send the student to school. This helps us keep EVERYONE safe and healthy!

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much, but absences add up!

When a student misses 2 days a month..	When a student misses 4 days a month..
They will miss 20 DAYS a year.	They will miss 40 DAYS a year.
They will miss 30 HOURS of math over the school year.	They will miss 60 HOURS of math over the school year.
They will miss 60 HOURS of reading & writing over the school year.	They will miss 120 HOURS of reading & writing over the school year.
They will miss over 1 YEAR of school by graduation.	They will miss over 2 YEARS of school by graduation.

All children must be screened and qualify to attend. Children do NOT need to demonstrate a delay in development in order to qualify for the Title 1 Preschool Program.
